

Roll a Color Alphabet Game

Preparation:

1. Cut out the squares with the color dots and tape one color to each side of a die (dice).
2. Write one letter on each colored square on the game board. I like to pick 6-8 letters to work on and repeat those over and over on the game board.
3. Gather 2 small items/toys to use as game pieces that will move along the game board. We like to use counting bears or tiny action figures.

Directions:

1. Roll the die and identify which color is facing up.
2. Move your game piece to the next instance of that color on the game board.
3. Identify the letter written on that square of the game board. For older kids, you can also ask them to say the sound the letter makes.
4. The 2nd player repeats steps 1-3 above.
5. This repeats until one player crosses over the finish line.

Add one square to each side of a die (dice)
